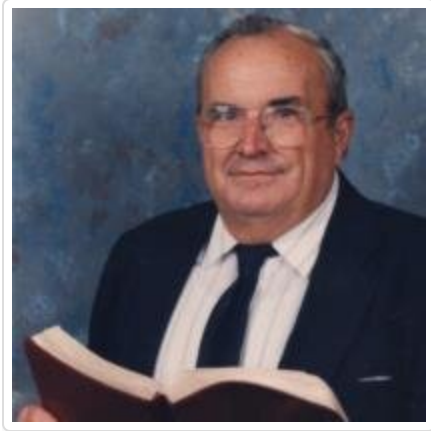




Albert Raymond Rowan
