



Boyce Hamilton Mullis

February 18, 1936 - October 10, 2018

Mr. Boyce Hamilton Mullis, age 82, of Monroe, NC, passed away October 10, 2018 at his residence.

A Celebration of Life service for Boyce will be held 2:00 PM Sunday, October 14, 2018, in the Davis Funeral Chapel, 1003 East Franklin Street, Monroe, NC, 28112, officiated by Reverend Dr. Shad Hicks. Interment will follow at Lakeland Memorial Park. After the burial committal service, a reception in Boyce's honor will be held at Davis Funeral Service.

Boyce Mullis was born February 18, 1936 in Union County, NC, a son of the late Julius "Jule" Caldwell Mullis and Mary Etta Melton Mullis.
