Buddy James Hatley, 75, of Oakboro passed away on Wednesday, December 8, 2021 at Atrium Health Main. He will lie in state at Stanly Funeral and Cremation Care in Albemarle on Monday, December 13, 2021 from 9AM-5PM. A celebration of life service will be held at 1:00 PM Tuesday, December 21, 2021 at West Albemarle Baptist Church in the Family Life Center officiated by Rev. Adam Hatley and Rev. Jason Hatley. The family will receive friends following the service. Burial will follow in the Liberty Hill Primitive Baptist Church Cemetery.

Mr. Hatley was born December 6, 1946 in Stanly County to the late James Charles Hatley and Minnie Belle Lambert Hatley. Bud was a farmer in Stanly County for over 40 years before retiring in 2017.
