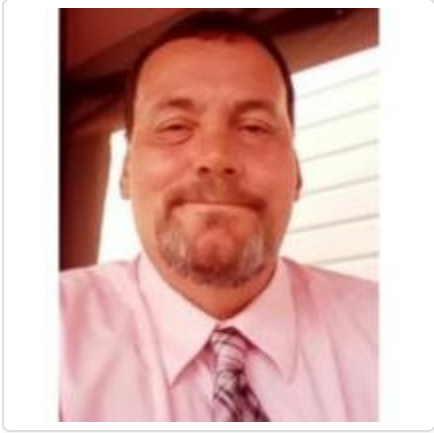




Christopher Shane Chavis
