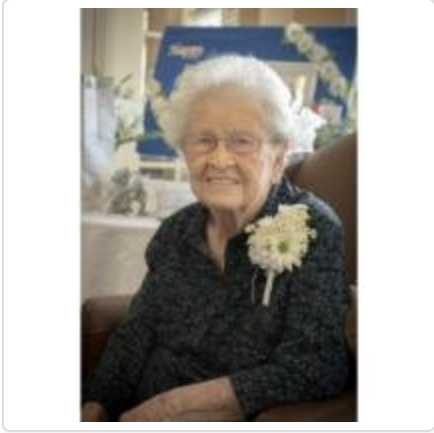




Edith Price Broome
