Edwin Hoyle Snuggs, 81, of Albemarle passed away Wednesday, February 17, 2016 in his home. His funeral service will be 11 AM Tuesday, February 23, 2016 in Randall's United Methodist Church with Rev. David McCauley officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends at Stanly Funeral Home on Monday evening from 6 until 8 PM.

Born August 12, 1934 in Moore County, NC, he was the son of the late Thomas Alva Snuggs and Eva Needham Snuggs and was a retired Sales Rep with Metropolitan Life. Mr. Snuggs was a member of Randall's United Methodist Church and a former member of Central United Methodist Church and a Veteran of the US Navy. During his college years, he was the Aquatics Director at the Stanly County YMCA. He was preceded in death by brothers Leon and Needham Snuggs and sister Gwendolyn Chapman.
