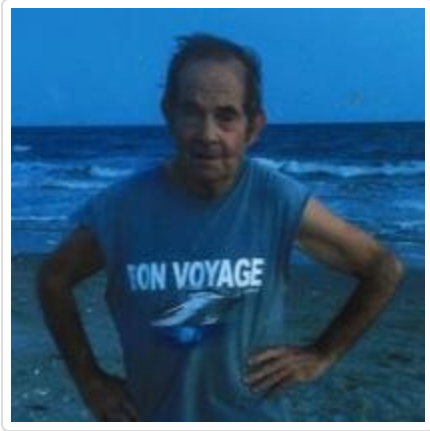




Edwin "Beaver" Wittman
