Mr. Garry Stanford Ritch, age 63, of Monroe, NC, passed away on Friday, July 9, 2021 at Atrium Health Union.

Services to honor Garry's life will be held at 1:00PM on Thursday, July 22, 2021 in the H. Vann Davis III Memorial Chapel at Davis Funeral Service, 1003 E. Franklin St. Monroe, NC, 28112, officiated by Rev. Frank Crump. Interment will immediately follow at Lakeland Memorial Park.
