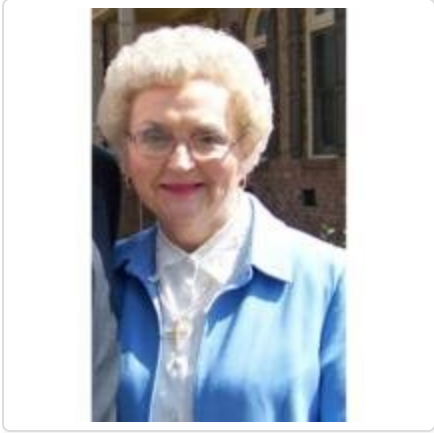




Jo Hinson Rollins
