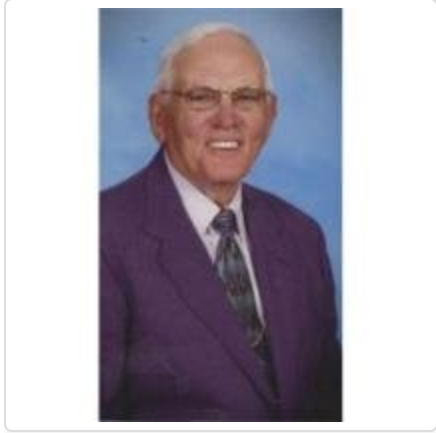




Junior Cauthen

Mr. Junior Cauthen, age 88, of Monroe, passed away on Wednesday, December 4, 2013, at his residence.
