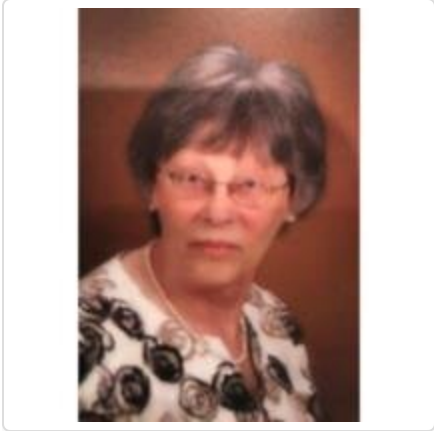




Rebecca Sue Wright
