Ruby Basinger Waisner, 76, of Albemarle passed away in CMC Main in Charlotte, NC on October 13. Her funeral will be 12 Noon Wednesday, October 19, 2016 at Luther's Lutheran Church, Richfield with Rev. Tommy Beaver officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends at the church from 11 AM until 12 Noon prior to the funeral service.

Ruby was born to Walter and Iris Basinger in Rowan County near Luther's Lutheran Church, a church her father helped build. She was one of thirteen children.
