Vaughn L. "Monk" Blake, 93, of Albemarle, N.C., passed away Friday March 3, 2017 in the N.C. State Veterans Home in Salisbury, N.C. His funeral service will be 11:00AM Monday, March 6, 2017 at Plyler Baptist Church with Dr. Dale Robertson officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery with military rites conducted by the Stanly County DAV Ritual Team. The family will receive friends on Sunday evening from 5:00PM until 7:00 PM at Stanly Funeral & Cremation Care.

Mr. Blake was born April 24, 1923 in Stanly County and was the son of the late Prince Albert Blake and Grace May Russell Blake. He was educated in the Stanly County Schools and retired from Wiscassett Mills.
