William Price 'Bill' Eudy, 95, of Albemarle, formerly of High Point, passed away Sunday, April 9, 2017 in Bethany Woods Nursing Center. His funeral service will be 11 AM Wednesday in the Albemarle Wesleyan Church with Rev. James Valk, Rev. John Vernon, Rev. Barry Whitley officiating. Burial will follow in Fairview Memorial Park. The family will receive friends from 10 until 11 AM at the Wesleyan Church prior to the service.
